Monitoring and Reforestation Progress Report

We continue to monitor trees on a monthly basis together with park rangers and the local community. As trees are affected by weather, pests and human activity, monthly monitoring provides an ongoing confirmation that the trees are healthy and growing. Nearly all 120,000 trees on 300 hectares of land are in good condition. Some trees have grown as large as this one (below).
